

AGSV/ APS JUNIOR C FAST 4 TENNIS REGULATIONS

To be read in conjunction with AGSV/APS Girls Tennis Regulations and the Return to Play information

'C' Level Tennis is a participation competition. The environment is to be inclusive and supportive.

Give players every opportunity to play as much tennis as possible.

The focus in this competition in order is etiquette, sportsmanship, play within the rules (learn the rules), the successes and failures.

Getting Started:

- Home Team Manager to welcome opposition and direct to appropriate courts
- Team managers to introduce all players to their opposition
- Warm up with respective doubles opposition for your first match
- Doubles play will commence with a prompt from the Team Managers at the scheduled time (see above).

Scoring:

- 0, 15, 30, 40, game. At 40 - 40 play a deciding point to determine winner of that game.
- First to 4 games. At 3 – 3, play one more game to decide the set. No tie-breaker and the final score will be 4 -3.
- Final set score reported to team manager and placed on score sheet

Points for / Sets won (singles and/or doubles):

- Scores recorded on score sheet as reported by players
- Winning team of set receives 1 point and losing team receives 0 points.
- Incomplete sets:
 - o Only recorded completed games on score sheet.
Example, If the set score is 2 -1 and game score is 30 – 15, when players are asked to stop, the game in progress does not get recorded.
 - o The recorded set score on the scoresheet would be 2 - 1.
 - o A point is awarded to the team that is leading the incomplete set.

Player attendance:

- Players are to be listed on the scoresheet in order of merit
 - Singles - best player listed as #1 and least experienced player as #8.
 - Doubles – Pair players up and list best team as #1 and least experienced as # 4 pair. The #1 singles player must play in the #1 doubles pair.
- Any players who do not have a direct opposition due to the opposition not having enough players will receive maximum points on the scoresheet. All scheduled matches for the attending will be recorded as 4 – 0 and points awarded as above.
- When there is no player from either team in attendance there will be no score recorded.

Winning Team on match day:

- Sub-total both singles and doubles sets won
- Add both Singles sub-total and Doubles Sub-total total to get the grand total of sets won.
- Record on scorecard.
- The team that wins the most amount of sets for the morning is declared the days winning team.

INSTRUCTIONS

- Step 1. Fill in all critical information - Date, Round, Level & Schools participating
- Step 2. List singles 'Order of Merit' - 1 being highest level and 8 lowest
- Step. 3. List Doubles 'Order of Merit' - Pair players together and list highest team as 1 and lowest as 4
- Step 4. Play Doubles first - Follow 'Match Order' as listed at bottom of score sheet
- Step 5. Record Doubles scores and cross off matches once played
- Step 6. Tally up Doubles points - transfer Doubles points sub-total to Singles Score Sheet
- Step 7. Singles matches follow Doubles - once Doubles are completed, commence singles
- Step 8. Singles played according to rank order on bottom of Singles score sheet
- Step 9. Record Singles scores and cross off matches once played
- Step 10. Tally up Singles points - record at bottom of Singles score sheet
- Step 11. Add Doubles and Singles sub total to give a grand total of points for the match
