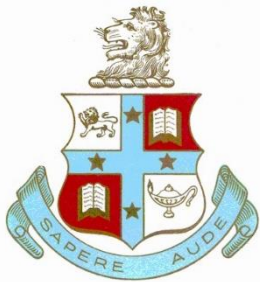

RULES & INFORMATION

As there are insufficient tracks for sprint races and hurdles, it has been necessary to run Heats in these events.

DIVISION ONE FINALISTS IN ALL TRACK EVENTS ARE:

- (a) 1st and 2nd placegetters in each heat;
- (b) the next two best times;
- (c) competitors who equal the second fastest time in (b) and cannot be judged slower.

The remainder will compete in Division 2.

After Qualifying for Division 1 on Wednesday, a school cannot gain points unless they enter a competitor in the event on the Saturday.

Points in all events shall be awarded as follows: 1st 12 points, 2nd 10 points, 3rd 9 points, 4th 8 points, 5th 7 points, 6th 6 points, 7th 5 points, 8th 4 points, 9th 3 points, 10th 2 points, 11th 1 point.

Where there are two finals, i.e., Division 1 & Division 2, points will be awarded in Division 2 Final as for 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th & 11th places, depending on the numbers in each final, eg:

Division 1: 1st - 12, 2nd - 10, 3rd - 9, 4th - 8, 5th - 7, 6th - 6.

Division 2: 1st - 5, 2nd - 4, 3rd - 3, 4th - 2, 5th - 1.

Any boy who does not finish or infringes in a Division 1 final receives 6 points; in a Division 2 Final or in the 1500 metres, 3000 metres or 4x800 metres Relay - 1 point.

For Multi Class (MC) events, points awarded commensurate with the number of competitors in each event (i.e. 3 competitors 1st = 3 points, 2nd = 2 points, 3rd = 1 point)

NOTE The numbers against the competitors' names in races indicate the position at the start from left to right, and in Field events the order of competing.

1. The meetings are conducted under the rules of the Athletics Victoria except:
 - (a) Long Jump, Triple Jump Discus and Shot Put, where each competitor is allowed three jumps and four throws/puts, respectively.
 - (b) Relays where dropping the baton does not disqualify the team.
2. The following rules will be observed in Relays:
 - (a) The baton must be handed, not thrown.
 - (b) If the baton is dropped at the changeover, it must be picked up by the runner who is delivering the baton.
 - (c) In all relays the changeover must take place within the prescribed area marked on the track.
 - (d) In the 4x100 metres Relays, when a competitor has handed over the baton, he must remain in the lane in which he is running until he can leave the track without interfering with the other teams.
 - (e) The 4x400 metres and 4x800 metres Relay will start and finish at the end of the home straight. The first 100m will be run in lanes. **Two competitors using lanes 3-5-7.**
 - (f) Incoming runners in the 4x800 metres and 4x400 metres must quickly move clear of other runners.
3. An athlete may not compete in the same event in more than one age group.
4. Boys who competed in the Heats may be replaced in the Finals.
5. The weight of the shot is: Open 6kg, U17 5kg, U16 & U15 4kg.
6. A boy, after winning the high jump, if he is still in the event, may have three more attempts (within the rules of jumping) at any height he may choose, provided that if he should break the record, he may have further attempts at a higher level.

If competitors tie for a place, this result will stand. There will be no jump off.

7. **Long Jump Records**

The APS competitors jumped from a metre square from 1961 to 1976 and these best performances are shown in brackets. The majority of these were from the board within the square. The record shown is the best jump from a board.

8. **Simultaneous Events**

Having reported to his field event, a competitor may excuse himself to take part in another event at the same time. Having left his field event, a competitor has 15 minutes from the last competitor completing his final round of that event to return and complete his remaining rounds.

INFORMATION BOARDS

Information Boards are provided on the ground at the High Jump, Long Jump, Triple Jump and Shot Put, so that spectators can watch the progress of these events.

The method of marking these boards is as follows:

(a) **Long Jump, Triple Jump & Shot Put**

The best distance will be shown against each competitor's school and an arrow will show who is the next competitor.

(b) **High Jump**

The competitors will be shown by their school name, and an arrow will point to the next competitor. If the competitor has jumped the height, he is known to have qualified at that height and this is shown by a tick beside his name. If he has knocked the bar down once at that height, this will be shown by an O against his school name. If he has knocked it twice at that height it will be shown as OU; if 3 times, OUT is shown. The height of the bar will be shown at the top of the board.

DATE FOR UNDER AGE & OPEN COMPETITORS

A competitor in under age events is under that age if his birthday is on or after 1 November this year. An Open competitor is under 19 if his birthday is on or after 1 January this year.
