# **Tennis Boys**

- Doubles and Singles sets to nine (9) games with a 12-point tie breaker at eight (8) games all.
- Doubles order: 1 v 1 2 v 2 3 v 3 4 v 4 then 1 v 2 2 v 1 3 v 4 4 v 3

# **Tennis Girls**

- Doubles and Singles sets to eight (8) games with a 12-point tie breaker (first to 7 with at least a two-point advantage) at seven (7) games all.
- Doubles order: 1 v 1 2 v 2 3 v 3 4 v 4 then 1 v 2 2 v 1 3 v 4 4 v 3
