SCHOOL DUTIES

Schools will need at least 2 staff/coaches to safely complete their official duties for each pit/mat/circle.

- Host School will provide folders with recording sheets and pens for each field event. School Officials allocated to these events (as below) must collect these prior to the event from near the finish line and return once their event has concluded.
- Host School will circulate these results sheets after the meet.
- Schools on horizontal pits will need a couple of additional staff/students to rake and hold the tape.
- In HJ schools are limited to 3 competitors in each age group.
- Starting blocks will be provided.
