

1. See General Regulations Governing Sporting Competitions.
2. Soccer is conducted under the rules of the Football Federation Victoria unless otherwise stated.
3. Depending on the size of the ground, corners can be taken from the corner of the penalty area, rather than the sidelines.
4. All free kicks shall be indirect.
5. Size 4 balls shall be used.
6. Games shall consist of a maximum 2 x 25 min halves.
7. Shin guards are compulsory, therefore no shin guards means no game for that student.
8. Mouthguards are highly recommended.
9. The interchange system is to be used rather than the substitute system.
10. Players at all levels should be strongly discouraged from disputing decisions of the referees.
11. The off-side rule should be played in 'A Games'. Discretion to be used in lower standard games.
12. Mercy Rule/Termination Score: The Mercy rule will be invoked when a team is 5 goals ahead. When one team leads by 5 goals the following strategies will apply: Rotate key players. If the score difference exceeds 8 goals, the game is terminated and teams are mixed up to provide a more even competition for the duration of the match. The Home team must provide bibs for this situation.
