## **SSV TENNIS**

A **round robin competition** to be held each season at a suitable venue e.g. Boroondara Tennis Centre or St. Kevin's College, Tooronga Playing Fields.

BALLS: It is recommended that the green Tennis balls (80% compression) be used for APS Primary Tennis. Schools may wish to negotiate to use the yellow Tennis balls (100% compression) for the upper pairs. If schools have players with a low skill level, the red Tennis balls (50% compression) may be used.

## PLAYER ETIQUETTE

- 1. Ball should be returned to the server along the ground.
- 2. The receiver must call a fault, and where possible not play it.
- 3. Racquets are not thrown.
- 4. Balls must not be hit wildly.
- 5. Umpires' decisions must be accepted graciously. If there are no umpires, doubtful points should be replayed.
- 6. Before the match begins introductions should be made, followed by toss of the coin or spin of a racquet.
- 7. At the conclusion of a set, shake hands and thank your opponent for the game. If there was an umpire, thank the person.
- 8. The server should call the score after each point.
- 9. Matches should be played either to an agreed time limit or first player to reach up to 6 games, whichever comes first.
- 10. In all games 'Sudden Death' is played at deuce (the player that wins the next point, wins the game). The receiver elects the side that the server serves to.
